

## Health Protocols for In-Person Worship at Good Shepherd Church

As of August 2, 2021

- 1. While indoors, we suggest that everyone wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status.
- 2. Only fifty (50) people will be permitted inside the sanctuary at any given celebration. At the door, we will have a greeter take the temperature direct you to a hand sanitizer table. The greeter will take names and phone numbers just in case we need to reach out to anyone.
- 3. If you feel sick and/or have a fever of 99.5 degrees Fahrenheit, we ask that you stay home and participate in the service via Zoom. Instructions for attending Zoom services are available on our website (<a href="www.goodshepherdbayridge.org">www.goodshepherdbayridge.org</a>).
- 4. No handouts or books will be provided in order to limit the transmission of virus. We suggest digitizing literature and programs. You can use our wireless network at our church location (wireless name: GSSanctuary, password: 7187458520).
- 5. You may sit with members of your household; otherwise you need to follow social distancing protocols.
- 6. Singing will not be permitted in order to further limit virus transmission. Our musicians will be up on the altar and all singing is pre-recorded.
- 7. There are two bathrooms fully equipped with touchless, sensor faucets and towel dispensers. Our doors and windows will be propped open to maximize air flow.
- 8. There will be no fellowship inside our building due to the recent increase in the rate of Covid 19 infections. We will, however, open the courtyard area next door for outside conversation and fellowship.
